

Carneval

Long jacket with wide flap and hat



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Quality:

Carneval (Gründl)

60 % Polyacryl, 40 % Schurwolle

50 g / 55 m

Size:

Jacket: Size 36/38 (40/42)

Hat: Head circumference approx. 54 cm - 57 cm

Required quantity:

Jacket: approx. 650 g (700 g) col. 02 (grey sand multi-colour)

Hat: approx. 100 g col. 02 (grey sand multi-colour)

Needle thickness:

Jacket: Round knitting needle 7.0 and 8.0

Hat: Crochet needle: 7.0 – 8.0, needle set: 7.0 – 8.0

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Pattern:

Stockinette stitch: rsr: ri st, wsr: le st

Ribs: rsr: 2 st ri, k 2 st le alternating, k the st as they appear in the wsr

Betonte decreases [RO1] (k in the rsr):

Beginning of row: est, 1 st ri, sl 1 st ri, k 1 st ri, pull the slipped st over

End of row: k to the 4th st before the end of the row, 2 st ri k tog., 1 st ri, est

Nodule – Edge stitches:

At the beginning of the row, knit as ri sl, at the end of the row knit ri.

Tension sample: (stockinette stitch, needle 8,0): 11 st x 15 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

Pattern: (varying instructions for the larger sizes indicated in brackets)

Back:

Cast on 60 (64) st plus 2 est with needle 7.0 and knit ribs, begin with a wsr, (est, 1 st le, * 2 st ri, 2 st le, from * rep., end with 2 st ri, 1 st le, est). In 12 cm (= 17 r) height continue stockinette stitch with needle 8.0 k in 52 (54) cm (= 77 (81) r) total height for the arm cut-outs obs 1 x 6 st c off (= 50 (54) st).

In 73 (76) cm (= 109 (115) R) total height for the shoulder slant obs 5 (6) st c off and then in e. 2nd r another 1 x 5 st and 1 x 4 st (2 x 5 st) c off simultaneously for the back neckline c off the middle 10 st and obs of that in e. 2nd r c off another 2 x 3 st.

Left front:

Cast on 23 (25) st plus 2 est with needle 7.0 and k ribs, begin with a wsr (est, 2 st ri, * 2 st le, 2 st ri, from * rep., end with 1 st le (2 st le, 1 st ri), est). In 12 cm (= 17 r) height continue knitting stockinette stitch with needle 8.0. Work the arm cut-outs and the shoulder slant on the ri working edge the same

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as on the back.

Simultaneously in 48 (51) cm (= 71 (77) r) total height for the v-neck in the following rsr on the le working edge 1 st betont decr[RO2] . and these decreases another 4 x in e. 8. r rep.

Right front: crochet backwards

Sleeves:

Cast on 28 st plus 2 est with needle 7.0 and k ribs, begin with a wsr (est, 1 st le, * 2 st ri, 2 st le, from * rep., end with 2 st ri, 1 st le, est). In 12 cm (= 17 r) height continue k stockinette stitch with needle 8.0, thereby for the sleeve slant in the 5th (3th) r from the beginning stockinette stitch obs 1 st incr. These additions another 8 (9) x alternately in e. 6th and 4th r rep. (= 48 (50) st).

In 52 (54) cm (= 77 (81) r) total height c off the st straight.

Completion:

Close the shoulder and sleeve seams, leaving the top 5 cm of the sleeve seam open.

From the front edges and from the back neckline edge a total of 196 (204) st with needle 7.0 (each 57 (61) st from the straight front edges, each 31 st from the v-neck edges and 20 st from the back neckline edge) and k ribs, begin with a wsr (est, 2 st le, * 2 st ri, 2 st le, from * rep., est). In 14 cm (= 21 R) height the c off st straight, thereby k the st as they appear.

Insert sleeves.

The flap folds outwards when worn.

Abbreviations:

rsr = right-side row • wsr = wrong-side row • ri = right • le = links • st = stitch • r = row • est = edge stitch • obs = on both sides • in e = in each • c off = cast off • incr. = increase • decr. = decrease • k tog. = knit together • rep. = repeat • col. = colour • k = knit • sl = to slip a stitch

Hat crocheted with knitted cuff:

Pattern:

Single crochet: Crocheted in rd., thereby always only insert the needle in the back loop.

Each rd. begins with 2 sl st as replacement for the 1st scr and ends with a ch in the 2nd beginning sl st.

Cuff pattern: in rd.

k 2 st ri, 2 st le alternating

Tension sample: (single crochet):

11 st x 11 rd. = 10 cm x 10 cm

Pattern:

The hat is crocheted in rd. from top to bottom.

Crochet In a thread ring 8 scr and close to a ring with 1 ch (= 1. rd.). Continue crocheting scr in rd., thereby always only puncture in the back loop.

2nd rd.: double each scr (= 2 scr in a insertion site) (= 16 st)

3rd rd.: double every 2nd scr (= 24 st)

4th rd.: double every 3rd scr (= 32 st)

5th rd.: crochet scr without increases

6th rd.: double every 4th scr (= 40 st)

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7th rd.: crochet scr without increases

8th rd.: double every 5th scr (= 48 st)

9th rd.: crochet scr without increases

10th rd.: double every 6th scr (= 56 st)

11th rd.: crochet scr without increases

12th rd.: double every 7th scr (= 64 st)

13th – 20th rd.: crochet scr without increases

Now with the needle set, knit 1 st from each scr of the bottom edge of the hat (= 64 st, per needle 16 st), thereby also insert only into the back loop. 8 rd. k in the cuff pattern and then c off the st straight, thereby the k st as they appear.

Abbreviations:

col. = colour • scr = single crochet • ch = chain stitch • rd. = round(s) • sl st = slip stitch(es) • st = stitch • c off = cast off • ri = right • le = left

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
