

Cottonwood

Poncho Pullover



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Quality:

Cottonwood (Gründl)
100 % cotton (biologisch)
50 g / 105 m

Size:

34 - 38 (40 - 44)

Usage:

approx. 400 (450) g Cl. 41104 (blue)

Needle size:

Circular knitting needle 3.5 - 4.5

Sample:

Braid hole pattern: (Stitch number divisible by 9 + 4 S + 2 ES)

Work according to knitting chart. Only the RSR is shown; in the BR, knt. the S as they occur, knt. the yov. le. Start with 1 ES, always rpt. the pattern set, end with the S according to the pattern set and 1 ES. Always rpt. the 1st - 2nd. R.

Collar pattern (stitch number divisible by 2 plus 1 S):

RSR: ES, alternately knt. 1 S le, 1 S ri, end with 1 S le, ES

BR: ES, alternately knt. 1 S ri and 1 S le, end with 1 S ri, ES

plain right: RSR: ri S, BR: le S

Edge stitches:

At row start, knt. as to ri, drop, kn. ri to row end.

Stitch test (measure hole pattern and collar pattern lying and slightly turned):

22 S x 28 R = 10 cm x 10 cm

Instructions: (differing information for the larger sizes are in brackets)

Back:

The back section is knitted transversely (see sketch). Cast on 97 (115) S plus 2 ES and knt. 2.5 cm (= 7 R) in the collar pattern, start with a BR. Then continue with the stitching as follows: 1 ES, 5 S collar pattern, 1 S plain right, 85 (103) S braid hole pattern, 1 S plain right, 5 S collar pattern, 1 ES In a total height of 62.5 (74.5) cm (= 175 (209) R), knt. another 2.5 cm (= 7 R) in the collar pattern. Then loosely co. all S, knitting the S as they occur.

Front

As with the back part.

Finishing:

Close each shoulder seam over 18.5 (22.5) cm, leave 28 (32) cm open for the neckline. Close the side seam (see sketch) over 10 (12) cm, leaving 12 (15) cm open for the arm opening and 22 (25) for the side slit. At the bottom of the pullover, attach each 2 fringe bundles to the right and left at a distance of 3 cm (1 fringe bundle = fold 6 threads in half and attach, finished length of outer fringe bundle approx. 18 cm, inner fringe bundle approx. 13 cm).

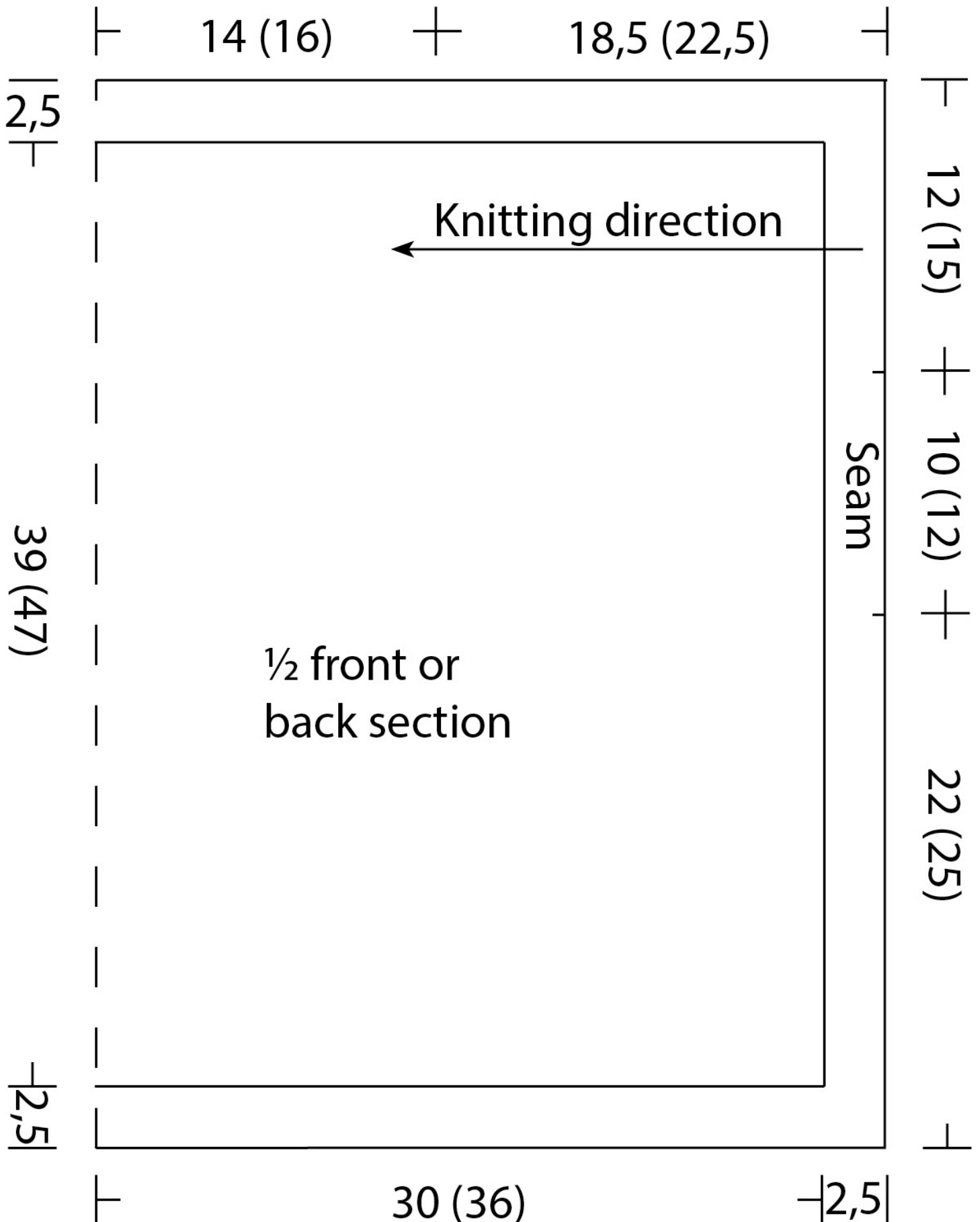
