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## Jacket

### Quality:

Teddy (Gründl)

75 % acrylic, 23 % wool, 2 % polyester

100 g / 74 m

**Size:** 36 - 40 (42 - 46)

**Usage:** approx. 700 (900) g Teddy Cl. 03 (blue multicoloured)

### Needle size:

Circular knitting needle 9.0 - 10.0

### Sample:

Collar pattern: alternately kn. 1 S ri and 1 S le

plain right: knt. RSR: ri S, BR: le S

plain left: knt. RSR le S, BR le S

End stitch: at row start ri lft., at row end, knt. ri.

### Stitch test (plain right):

7.5 S x 11 R = 10 cm x 10 cm

**Instructions:** (the information for the sizes 42-46 are in brackets)

#### Back:

Cast on 37 (45) S plus 2 ES and knt. 4 cm (= 5 R) in the collar pattern, start with 1 BR. Then continue knt. plain right between the ES. In 16 (12) cm (= 17 (13) R) total height for the V-line, pck. 1 S on both sides as follows: at the row start knt. the 1st S after the ES and 2 S at the row end from the last S before the ES (= 1 S ri, 1 S ri interlaced). rpt. these pickups another 3 x in each 16th (18th) R (= 47 (55) S) and then continue knt. straight up.

In 78 (84) cm (= 85 (91) R) total height for the shoulder slant boths., co. 5 (6) S and in each 2nd R cast off another 2 x 6 (7). In the following RSR, co. the remaining 13 (15) S, knt. ri S.

#### left front:

First knt. the inside of the pocket: cast on 12 S and kn. 18 cm (20 R) plain right, start with a BR. Then set down all S.

Cast on 18 (22) S plus 2 ES and knt. 4 cm (= 5 R) in the collar pattern, start with 1 BR. Then continue knitting the stitches as follows: ES, 16 (20) S plain right, 1 S plain left, 1 S plain right, ES Prepare the pickups for the V line at the right working edge (= start of row) in the same way as the back part (= 21 (26) S).

At a total height of 29 (31) cm (= 32 (34) R), knt. the pocket opening in the following BR as follows: ES, 1 S le, 1 S ri, 3 (5) S le, 12 S ri, 2 (5) S le, ES In the following RSR, co. the 12 le S, knt. ri S and knt. the R according to the pattern to the end. In the following BR, add the inside of the pocket (= 12 S) at the point of the cast off S, knt. le S.

For the neckline, at a total height of 72 (76) cm (= 79 (83) R), drp. in the following RSR at the left working edge as follows: ES, 18 (22) S plain right, knt. tog. 2 S ri pulled over. (= lft. 1 S ri, knt. 1 S ri., pull over the lifted S) 1 S le, 1 S ri, ES Rpt. the drops over the 3rd + 4th S before the ES another 5 (6) x in each 2nd R.

At the same time, for the shoulder slant, at 78 (84) cm (= 85 (91) R) total height, co. 6 (7) S at the

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right working edge and in each 2nd R cast off another 2 x 6 (7).

### right front:

Work mirror-inverted to the left front part. To do so, continue knt. according to the collar pattern as follows: ES, 1 S plain right, 1 S plain left, 16 (20) S plain right, ES

Knt. the drops for the neckline (= right working edge) as follows: (=RSR): ES, knt. tog. 1 S ri, 1 S le, 2 S ri, 18 (22) S plain right, ES Rpt. the drops over the 3rd + 4th S after the ES another 5 (6) x in each 2nd R.

### Sleeve:

Cast on 18 S plus 2 ES and knt. 4 cm (= 5 R) in the collar pattern, start with 1 BR. Then continue knt. plain right. At a total height of 10 cm (= 11 R), for the arm slant on both sides, pck. 1 S, to do so, in the following RSR at the row start, from the 1st S after the ES and at the row end from the last S before the ES, knt. 2 S (= 1 S ri, 1 S ri interlaced). Rpt. these pickups another 3 (6) x in each 10th (6) R (= 28 (34) S) and then continue knt. straight up. At a total height of 41 (46) cm (= 45 (51) R), co. all S in the following RSR, knt. ri S.

Knt. the 2nd sleeve in exactly the same way..

### **Finishing:**

Close the shoulder seams. Attach the sleeves. Close sleeve and side seam as flat as possible.

Cl. = colour(s) • S = stitch(es) • R = row(s) • ES = edge stitch(es) • ri = right • le = left • RSR = right-side row(s) • BR. = back row(s) • kn. = knit • rpt. = repeat • boths. = both sides • i. e. = in each one • co. = cast off • pck. = pick up • drp. = drop • kn. tg. = knit together • drp = lift

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
