

Rosella

Crocheted Triangular Shawl



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Quality:

Rosella (Gründl)

50 % acrylic, 50 % cotton

200 g / 820 m

Size: Top edge: approx. 180 cm, Height from the bottom point to the top edge: approx. 70 cm

Usage: approx. 200 g in col. 04 (mandarine, copper, honey yellow and jeans blue)

Materials: 1 crochet hook size 4,0 mm - 5,0 mm or size needed to achieve given tension.

Tension: 10 rows after start of shawl = Upper edge 26 cm wide and from start to upper edge of work 12,5 cm

Instructions:

The beginning of the shawl is in the centre of the long edge.

4 ch and close to a ring with a slst.

Row 1: 4 ch(as replacement for the first tr), then into the ring work 2 tr, 1 ch (centre of shawl) 3 tr. Turn work.

Row 2: 4 ch(as replacement for the first tr), then 2 tr between the last and 2nd to last tr of the previous row, tr 3 into the centre ch of shawl, 1 ch, 3 tr, 2 tr between the first tr and the ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4th ch of the previous row. Turn work.

Row 3: 4 ch(as replacement for the first tr), then 2 tr between the last and 2nd to last tr of the previous row, tr 3 between the next two tr groups (= 3 tr) of the previous row, 3 tr into the centre st, 1 ch, 3 tr, 3 tr between the next two tr groups (= 3 tr) of the previous row, 2 tr between the first tr and the ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4th ch of the previous row. Turn work.

Row 4: 4 ch(as replacement for the first tr), then 2 tr between the last and 2nd to last tr of the previous row, tr 3 between the next tr groups (= 3 tr) of the previous row until centre of work, 3 tr into the centre st, 1 ch, 3 tr, 3 tr between the next tr groups (= 3 tr) of the previous row until the last tr group then 2 tr between the first tr and the ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4th ch of the previous row. Turn work.

Repeat row 4 cont. throughout.

The edges of the shawl and the centre are always worked the same. The increases are created in each row with a new group of treble sts on each side of the shawl.

Cont. work until the ball is almost completely used.

Last row: 1 ch(as replacement for the first slst), then 1 slst each into the next two tr, * 1 ch, 1 slst each into the next 3 tr, rep from * being careful not to work the sts too tight. Pull yarn through last st and weave in ends. Pin out shawl to measurements given, cover with a clean, damp cloth and leave to dry naturally out of sunlight. Do not steam press.
