

Amore

Oversized Jumper



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Quality:

Amore (Gründl)
67 % acrylic, 19 % wool, 14 % polyamide
100 g / 120 m

Size: 36 - 40 [42 - 46]

Usage: approx. 400 [500] g in col. 01 (mottled-royal blue-grey-indigo)

Needles: 1 pair of circular needles in size 9,0 - 10,0mm or size needed to achieve given tension.

Pattern:

Ribbing: (amount of sts multiple of 2 plus 1)

WS row: 1 selvedge st, alt p1, k1 to last 2 sts then p1, 1 selvedge st.

RS rows: work the sts between the selvedge sts as they appear (k the knit sts and p the purl sts).

Stockinette st: k in RS rows and p in WS rows.

Garter st selvedge: k first st in row and sl last st p-wise wyif.

Tension:

9 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm meas over stockinette st. using size 9mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions: (changes for the larger size are given in brackets. If only one number is shown, this applies to both sizes).

Back:

Cast on 51 [59] sts (including selvedge sts) and work 4 rows in ribbing. Beg with a WS row. Then work even in stockinette st between the selvedge sts for a total of 63 [66] cm (= 86 [92] rows). Then beg shoulder shaping in the next WS row:

Row 87 [93]: selvedge st, 45 [54] sts in established patt, turn work.

Row 88 [94]: 1 yo, 41 [51] sts, turn work.

Row 89 [95]: 1 yo, 37 [47] sts, turn work.

Row 90 [96]: 1 yo, 33 [43] sts, turn work.

Row 91 [97]: 1 yo, 29 [39] sts, turn work.

Row 92 [98]: 1 yo, 25 [35] sts, turn work.

Row 93: **(only for smaller size)** 1 yo, work in established patt to end of row over all sts, working the yos with the foll st as p2tog.

[! Rows 99 - 101: **Only for larger size!**

Row 99: yo, 31 sts, turn work.

Row 100: 1 yo, 27 sts, turn work.

Row 101: 1 yo, work in established patt to end of row over all sts, working the yos with the foll st as p2tog.

Row 94 [102]: (RS) cast off all 51 [59] sts k-wise and work the yos with the foll sts as k2tog while casting off.

Front:

Work as for back. The front is a total of 7cm shorter than the back, therefore start the short rows when work meas 55 [58] cm (= 76 [80] rows) working the left side first:

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Row 77 [81] (= WS row) 1 selvedge st, 19 [23] sts, turn work.

Row 78 [82]: 1 yo, 19 [23] sts, selvedge st.

Row 79 [83]: 1 selvedge st, 16 [21] sts, turn work.

Row 80 [84]: 1 yo, 12 [18] sts, turn work.

Row 81 [85]: 1 yo, 10 [16] sts, turn work.

Row 82 [86]: 1 yo, 12 [18] sts, turn work.

Row 80 [84]: 1 yo, 6 [12] sts, turn work.

Row 81 [85]: 1 yo, 10 [16] sts, turn work.

Row 82 [86]: 1 yo, 46[12] sts, turn work.

Row 83 [87]: 1 yo, 4 [10] sts, turn work.

[! Rows 88 - 89: **Only for larger size!**

Row 88: yo, work over next 6 sts, turn work.

Row 89: 1 yo, work over next 4 sts, turn work.

Row 84 [90]: 1 yo, work to end of row over all sts, working the yos with the foll st tog.

Now work the right side mirroring the decs as foll:

Row 77 [81]: (= WS) 1 selvedge st, work over next 31 [35] sts, turn work.

Row 78 [82]: 1 yo, 19 [23] sts, selvedge st.

Row 79 [83] - Row 84 [90]: work as for the left side.

Row 85 [91]: (RS) cast off all sts k-wise working the yos with the foll st as k2tog.

Sleeve:

Cast on 27 [29] sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and work 3 rows in ribbing. Beg with a WS row and then cont in stockinette st. For the sleeve shaping inc 1 st on each side (M1 tbl under the horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch on left needle) in every 6th row 6 [7] times at the beg and end of the row next to the selvedge st. (= 39 [43] sts). Then work even until sleeve meas total of 36 [39] cm (= 50 [54] rows). Work the sleeve cap in short rows as foll:

Row 51 [55]: (WS) 1 selvedge st, work over next 31 [35] sts, turn work.

Row 52 [56]: 1 yo, 25 [29] sts, turn work.

Row 53 [57]: 1 yo, 18 [21] sts, turn work.

Row 54 [58]: 1 yo, 11 [29] sts, turn work.

Row 55 [59]: 1 yo, work over all sts to end of row working the yos with the foll st as p2tog.

Row 56 [60]: cast off all sts k-wise working the yos with the foll st as k2tog.

Work 2nd sleeve the same.

Finishing:

Close shoulder seam so the seam lies on the outside. To do so, place the needle next to the cast off st or selvedge st so the cast off st or the selvedge st is on the outside of the jumper. Set in the sleeves using the same technique.

Close sleeve seam using a mattress st, picking up the sts in the middle of each selvedge st. Close side seams also using mattress st, but leave the lower 11 cm on the front piece and the lower 18 cm on the back open.
