

Alaska uni

Hat in garter stitch



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Quality:

Alaska uni (Gründl)
80 % acrylic, 20 % wool
100 g / 75 m

Required quantity:

approx. 100 g col. 05, turquoise,
1 fur pompon size L col. 47, turquoise

Needle thickness:

10.0 – 12.0

Knitting pattern:

garter stitch: RSR and WSR: k st

Tension sample (garter stitch):

9 stitches x 18 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Knitting pattern:

The hat is knitted straight, in right- and wrong-side rows.

Cast on 42 st plus 2 est, and knit in garter stitch between the est, starting with one WSR.

After a total length of 14 cm (= 25 r) decrease as follows:

26th r: between the est, k tog every 6th and 7th st (= 38 st)

30th r: between the est, k tog every 5th and 6th st (= 32 st)

34th r: between the est, k tog every 4th and 5th st (= 26 st)

36th r: between the est, k tog every 3rd and 4th st (= 20 st)

38th r: between the est, always k tog 2 st (= 11 st)

Pull the working yarn through those 11 st twice, and pull it together. Close the back with as flat a seam as possible and attach the fur pompon to the hat.
