

Alaska uni

Hat with cable



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Quality:

Alaska uni (Gründl)
80 % acrylic, 20 % wool
100 g / 75 m

Required quantity:

approx. 100 g col. 02, red, 1 fur pompon size L col. 43, red

Needle thickness:

10.0 – 12.0, cable needle

Knitting pattern:

Cuff pattern (number of stitches can be divided by 2):

1st row (= WSR): est, * k 1, p 1 through back loop, repeat after *, est

2nd row (= RSR): est, * k 1 through back loop, p 1, repeat after *, est

always repeat 1st and 2nd r

cable over 6 st:

1st r: knit stitches, 2nd r: purl stitches

3rd r: left cross 6 st = slip 3 st onto cable needle in front of your work, k 3, then knit the stitches on the cable needle

4th r: purl stitches, 5th r: knit stitches, 6th r: purl stitches

always repeat 1st – 6th row

reverse stocking stitch: RSR: p st, WSR: k st

Tension sample (stocking stitch):

9 stitches x 12 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Knitting pattern:

The hat is knitted straight, in right- and wrong-side rows.

Cast on 42 st plus 2 est, and k 4 cm (= 5 r) in cuff pattern, starting with one WSR. Continue

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as follows: 1 est, * p 2 in reverse stocking stitch, 6 st in cable pattern, p 1 in reverse stocking stitch, rep 5 times after *, est, for that increase by 12 st in 1st r:

1 est, * p 2, k 1, k 1 through back loop from the transverse yarn, k 2, k 1 through back loop from the transverse yarn, k 1, p 1, repeat 5 times after *, est (= 56 st). After a total length of 19 cm (= 23 r) decrease as follows:

24th r: over the cables, k tog 2 x 2 st (= 44 st)

26th r: p tog 2 each over the purl st (= 38 st).

28th r: over the 4 knit st, k tog 2 x 2 st (= 26 st) in the WSR: knit stitches as they appear

30th r: est, p 1, * k tog 2, p tog 2, repeat after *, and k tog the last purl st with the est (= 14 st)

31st r: always p tog 2 st (= 8 st)

Pull together the last 8 stitches with the working yarn. Close the back with as flat a seam as possible and attach the fur pompon to the hat.

Abbreviations:

est = edge stitch • st = stitch • r = row • yo = yarn over • RSR = right-side row

WSR = wrong-side row • k = knit • p = purl • rep. = repeat • k tog = knit together
